The visit of Kamala Chandrakirana to the ANU was extremely productive, especially in a policy and media sense, but we had trouble engaging ECRs.

On Monday 4th November, Kamala spoke at an AusAID workshop on gender equality in the Indonesia country strategy (30 staff).

On Tuesday 5th November 2013 — Kamala spoke about her UN Special Procedures mandate with ACFID members, hosted by Care Australia (12 attendees). She then met with the Indonesian Students Association and several ANU researchers on Indonesia (15 attendees).

On Wednesday 6th November 2013, we held an ECR workshop with 5 registered but only one final participant. The keynote lecture in the APCD theatre 1 was excellent with 30 attendees.

On Thursday, 7 November 2013, there was a meeting at AusAID with Ali Gillies, Assistant Director General, Fragility & Conflict Branch, Humanitarian & Stabilisation Division, AusAID to discuss the Women Peace and Security agenda (15 senior staff).

Finally there was a lunch meeting with the ANU 2014 conference WPS team with a very lively discussion and agreement on a way forward.
