Gender in Modern East Asia explores the history of women and gender in China, Korea, and Japan from the seventeenth century onwards. This unique volume places the three countries in global and regional contexts, connecting the cultural, economic, and social developments in East Asia to what is happening across the wider world.

Important themes and topics of the book include Confucianism, writing and language, the role of the state in gender construction, nationalism, sexuality and prostitution, New Women and Modern Girls, feminisms, "comfort" women, and imperialism.
