Professor Nevena Petrusic is the inaugural elected Commissioner for the Protection of Equality in Serbia. She was a member of The Governmental Gender Equality Council in Serbia, and the Council for Children's Rights, and a member of the expert groups which drafted Serbia's national gender equality law, and its model law for legal protection against domestic violence.

Dr Petrusic is a Professor, and former Dean, at

the Faculty of Law at the University of Niš in Serbia, where she teaches civil process and arbitration law. She has taught, trained, researched and written extensively on civil process, family relationships, domestic violence and the human rights of women and children. She co-founded the Women's Research Centre, and the Association for Women and Children Victims of Violence, and is a member of the Serbian Lawyers Association, the Association for Arbitration and Civil Process Law, the Victimology Society of Serbia and the Center for Mediation.
